**From: IFUW Resolutions Committee**  
**Subject: Call for Resolutions for the 30<sup>th</sup> IFUW Triennial Conference**  
**Mexico City, 5 – 9 August 2010 – Deadline 5 February 2010**

Resolutions approved at Triennial Conferences add an important dimension to the purpose, programme and mission of IFUW. They form IFUW policy and give direction to National Federations and Associations (NFAs) and the IFUW leadership. They also provide focal points for NFA lobbying efforts with their respective governments and give guidance to our representatives at the United Nations to speak on our behalf. Internal resolutions address the governance and functioning of the Federation.

### **Deadline for proposing resolutions**

- All national federations and associations, the IFUW Board of Officers, IFUW standing committees and IFUW special committees may propose resolutions.
- All resolutions must be **received** by IFUW Headquarters by 5 February 2010, six months prior to the Conference.
- Only emergency resolutions relating to unexpected events occurring after 5 February 2010 may be submitted after that date. The Conference will vote on whether to admit an emergency resolution for debate; a two-thirds majority of the voting delegates is required.

### **Submissions**

- Resolutions on public policy must be consistent with the purposes of IFUW.
- If IFUW has previously adopted a policy resolution on the subject, the new proposal must refer to the exact IFUW policy to be **reaffirmed** and supply updated background information. Reaffirmation is made in order to highlight existing IFUW policy for a specific purpose such as presentation to a UN conference or reaction to a current world event. - All resolutions must include a supporting statement and an action plan. The maximum length of the submission, including the text of the resolution is **one A4 page**.
- Proposers should use the attached submission form, which is also available on the IFUW website at [www.ifuw.org/ifuw2010/resolutions/form.doc](http://www.ifuw.org/ifuw2010/resolutions/form.doc).
- The submission form, together with any optional supplementary materials should be sent as an e-mail attachment to [resolutions@ifuw.org](mailto:resolutions@ifuw.org). Please read the instructions on the form carefully.

### **Resolutions at Conference**

- The resolutions will be presented in an informal session to give an opportunity for discussion and possible further amendment prior to voting. The NFAs presenting the resolution will lead the discussion.
- An opportunity will also be given to presenters of proposed resolutions on IFUW public policy to develop the issues emerging from their proposed resolution during special interactive workshop(s) especially organized for this purpose. Interest to participate in such informal debates should be expressed when proposing a resolution, and no later than 5 February 2010. More details will be sent to those involved.
